


**Life Science Project: D.N.A. – PROOF OF OUR GOOD SHEPHERD CREATOR Mr. Galloway**

*Life-Project-D.N.A.-Proof-Good-Shepherd-Creator*

**\*\* DON'T WORRY, this little project can be done in class this week under Mr. Galloway's guidance. Most of you should not need to work on it much or even at all at home.**



**OBJECTIVE:** To be able to understand and present evidence that shows how and why the information coded into DNA is proof of an intelligent Designer (programmer), not chance chemical processes. D.N.A. is Designed Not Accidental.

**RESOURCES:** Mr. Galloway will guide you during class to a few sources on his Good Shepherd Initiative website (SoulCare.ORG), and will send you a few items you can use to complete the project.

**INSTRUCTIONS-REQUIREMENTS:** You may do your project EITHER as a power point or a written paper. The choice is yours. Most students find a power point to be more fun, easier, and more interesting for others to view. Only Mr. Galloway will see your project, not other students.

**Your power point or paper must include the following:**

1. An **INTRODUCTION** explaining the purpose of your project.
  - if you do a power point, you can set up your introduction in one or two slides.
  - if you do a paper, then the introduction needs to be a paragraph of at least four sentences.
2. **EVIDENCE** backing up (supporting) leading to the belief that the information in DNA must have come from an intelligent Designer.  
You must cite sources for each evidence you find in research and use.  
You should use at least four evidences
  - if you do a power point, you may use bullet points for evidence you use
    - \* but they must be complete enough as a statement to be clear to a reader or viewer
    - \* each evidence should have a separate power point slide
  - if you do a paper, you must write in complete sentences
    - \* each evidence should have a separate paragraph
3. A **CONCLUSION** that clearly summarizes how the evidence you cited in # 2 proves beyond reasonable doubt that DNA had to have been designed by an Intelligent Creator, not by chance chemical reactions.
  - your conclusion should show or describe how the evidences logical lead to the conclusion
  - your conclusion should be one or two slides or paragraphs
